After entering the service April 10, 1967, he received basic training at Ft. Leonard Wood and advanced individual training at Ft. Polk, Louisiana.

Survivors, in addition to the parents, include a brother, Tommy Hatfield, and a sister, Miss Janet Hatfield, both of the home.

The body will be returned for services under direction of Thornhill-Dillon mortuary.
