January 31, 1947 - August 18, 1967

Jerry Dale Moss, 20, 102 North Schifferdecker Avenue, was killed sometime between 2 and 3 o'clock Friday morning in a one-car accident north of Galena Kansas on the old highway 66.

Galena police found the wreckage about 6 o'clock Friday morning and Moss was pronounced dead at the scene by Dr. V. Dale Alquist, coroner.

Trooper Charles Scott of the Kansas highway patrol said Moss was east bound when the car, a 1962 convertible, failed to negotiate a curve and went down an embankment. Moss was apparently thrown from the auto and it overturned on him causing a fatal head wound.

He was born January 31, 1947, at Picher, Okla. and moved to Joplin in 1952. He was employed as a lift driver for the Moore division of the Joplin Cement Company.

Surviving are the widow, Mrs. Galene Moss; one son, Jerry Edward Moss of the home; his parents, Mr. and Mrs Floyd E. Moss of the home; two brothers Jimmy Lee Moss, Carl Junction; and Jackie Donald Moss, of the home.
